What are shortcut keys?

Shortcut keys allow you to call up our toolpath features by using your keyboard. Instead of clicking on an icon or menu item, simply access it from your keyboard for quick processing.

HOW DO SHORTCUT KEYS WORK?

By using a combination of keys on your keyboard to launch the desired feature. A combination of keyboard and mouse functions is also possible.

LET'S GET STARTED...

General Shortcuts:

- File New = Ctrl + N
- File Open = Ctrl + O
- Print = Ctrl + P
- Save = Ctrl + S
- Help = F1
- Copy = Ctrl + C
- Paste = Ctrl + V
- Undo = Ctrl + Z
- Redo = Ctrl + Y
- Right Click OK = Spacebar

Viewing Shortcuts:

- Top View = Ctrl + 1
- Front View = Ctrl + 2
- Right View = Ctrl + 3
- Pan = Ctrl + Center Mouse
- Rotate = Ctrl + Right Mouse
- Zoom = Mouse Wheel

Selection Shortcuts:

- Select All = Ctrl + A
- Chain Select = Shift + Left Mouse
- Loop or Constant Z (For surface edges) = Right Mouse

Why should you care?

It's faster to use a common feature by using the keyboard vs a mouse click.
